Child Protection & Safeguarding Policy WorldTutors: Virtually Everywhere Effective August 11, 2026 |

1. Purpose & Commitment WorldTutors: Virtually Everywhere (the "Organization") is committed to providing a safe environment for every child and youth who participates in its programs, services, and events. The protection of minors is a shared responsibility of staff, volunteers, board members, and contractors. This Child Protection & Safeguarding Policy establishes the standards, screening requirements, supervision practices, conduct rules, and reporting obligations designed to prevent abuse and to respond promptly and appropriately whenever a concern arises. It supplements - and does not replace - any applicable state and federal law governing the protection of minors in Connecticut and elsewhere.

2. Scope & Who Is Covered: This policy applies to every adult who has contact with or responsibility for minors through the Organization, including: Employees and paid staff, full-time, part-time, seasonal, and temporary; Volunteers, interns, mentors, coaches, chaperones, and group leaders; Board members, officers, and committee members who participate in programs; Contractors, vendors, and their personnel who work in proximity to minors. For the purpose of this policy, a "minor" is any person under the age of eighteen (18), and "covered adult" means any of the persons described above.
